A gathering for post-graduate/doctoral students will take place in the College of Music, Örebro University, Tuesday 20 January, 2009; the day before the actual conference of Nordic Network of Research in Music Education.

The PhD-day starts at 12:00 (local time) with lunch and seminars taking place between 13:00-17:00. In the evening there will be an informal meeting and dinner. It is possible to make time for a discussion Wednesday morning as well. The professors Christer Bouij, Gunnar Ternhag and Øivind Varkøy will lead the seminars.

Notice: All food and drinks are at cost price. There is no increased conference charge to take part. To be able to participate you still need to register on the conference registration form (see www.oru.se/NNMPF2009).

Presentations / Texts

Texts and drafts in progress are invited (but you don't need to send in anything more than your application to participate). Texts, including contact information, should be submitted as a Word document via email to NNMPF09@oru.se by November 15. Please state "Text to PhD-day" in title box.

The seminars will deal with some themes/problems concerning the work of dissertation. A submitted text will serve as the starting point for a discussion, not as a manuscript for a formal presentation. The seminar leaders are responsible for accepting or rejecting submissions on the basis of this purpose. Acceptance letters will be sent in January - manuscripts, advice and instructions for all participants as well.

Texts may be in Swedish, Norwegian, Danish or English. Discussions will be held in 'Nordic' to the greatest extent possible, but considering language comprehension, the conversation could be continued in English.
